As part of our Summer Club activities, we will be enjoying the new aquatic center this summer. It is scheduled to open after our first week of Summer Club. As in prior years we will require you to purchase a swimming pool season pass for your child. You can contact the city office for this. According to the city's website it is \$75 for individuals or \$200 for a family of up to 4 people. If your child will not be attending all summer or if this is not possible for you, please contact me so we can work something out.

The plan is to walk there Monday, Wednesday & Friday one week and Tuesday & Thursday the next week. This will be subject to change depending on holidays, weather, other activities we have scheduled and so on. The pool days will be marked on the dry erase calendar & we will post on the Facebook group. The plan is to leave the school at 1:15pm and arrive back at 3:45pm for snack time & pick up. My plan is to have kids change at school since we will not have a male staff member to monitor the boys in the pool bathhouse. The first week or two may be a bit of a trial period so this plan may change. Although we would like to have kids picked up from the school as much as possible, if they need to be picked up early, please let us know so we can have their belongings along.

I have attached both a brief list of items your child will need for swimming as well as rules I ask you to review with your child beforehand and throughout the summer as needed. In order to be a fun experience, we all need to be respectful and safe.

Please return the form prior to Memorial Day. I am excited we will have this new option this year to keep us busy and look forward to your help and understanding while we get the plan smoothed out! Feel free to contact me with questions.

PLEASE DO NOT SEND EXTRA ITEMS (money, toys, jewelry, sunglasses, etc.) that are not on the list unless you talk to staff prior. We are unable to be responsible for these items and your child will be asked to leave them at school.

We will provide and apply sunscreen prior to walking to the pool. If your child needs a specific sunscreen please supply.

Children will put on a shirt, and shorts for girls, to walk after swimming, they will change at the school. So, if they do not want to be in wet clothes until pick up time, they will need to bring an extra outfit & shoes if necessary.

Swimming Rules

Please review with your child prior to swimming at the beginning of summer and throughout the summer as needed. In order to have a fun experience we need everyone to be respectful and safe.

- I will listen to the Summer Club and pool staff in charge at ALL times.
- I will follow ALL instructions quickly and quietly.
- I will follow all whistle blows quickly as I know that this is important to keep me safe.
- I am responsible for my own clothing and items and will keep everything together where instructed.
- I will change quickly and quietly.
- I will follow all rules of the pool.
- I will NOT splash, push or pull any other child.
- I will NOT run since it could be slick and I could fall.
- I will only enter the pool after I am told it is ok.
- I will only go in the pool areas that I am allowed to swim in.
- I will not go off the slides unless I ask a Summer Club staff first.
- I understand that if I cannot follow these rules, I will have to take a break to think about what I did wrong. If I have 3 breaks, I will be asked to sit out for the remainder of the day.
- I understand that if I am routinely having problems following the rules I will lose the privilege of going to the pool for a time period designated by the Summer Club director. If problems continue, I will lose my pool privilege for the remainder of summer.
